## Recipe of the Month

### Roasted Leg of Lamb

Prep Time: 20 min

Cook Time: 1 hr & 45 min

Yield: 8 servings

#### INGREDIENTS:

- 1 { 5 lb } bone-in leg of lamb, trimmed
- 4 cloves of garlic, minced
- 1 tbsp olive oil
- 1 tbsp chopped fresh rosemary
- 1 tbsp chopped fresh thyme leaves
- 1 tbsp Dijon mustard
- 1 tbsp kosher salt
- 2 tsp ground black pepper

#### Directions:

1. 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Line a roasting pan with aluminum foil.
2. 2. Using paper towels, pat lamb dry. Using a sharp knife, score the top side of the lamb by making shallow cuts in a diamond pattern.
3. 3. In a small bowl, combine garlic, olive oil, rosemary, thyme, Dijon, salt and pepper.
4. 4. Place lamb, fat side up, on a rack in the prepared roasting pan. Spread garlic mixture evenly over the lamb, rubbing in thoroughly into the scored cuts.
5. 5. Place into oven and roast until it reaches an internal temperature of 135 degrees F for medium, about 1 hour 30 minutes to 1 hour 45 minutes or until desired doneness. Let rest 15 minutes before slicing.
6. 6. Serve immediately with scalloped potatoes or other potatoes and asparagus.
