Recipe of the Month

Almond Haystacks

These cookies taste great and are also gluten free & easy to make!!!

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 egg whites
- ½ cup granulated sugar
- ½ tsp vanilla
- 3 cups sliced almonds

Instructions::

1. Preheat the oven to 350°F and line two baking sheets with parchment paper.
2. In a large bowl, stir the egg whites with the sugar. Do not beat, just stir together well. Add the vanilla and almonds and coat well with the sugary mixture.
3. Use 1 heaping Tbsp of the mixture for each cookie. Mound on the lined baking sheets and gently flatten the cookies with the back of the spoon (dipped in water if sticky).
4. Bake for 12 to 15 minutes or until the cookies are browned. For crispier cookies, turn off the oven after baking and let the cookies rest for another 15 minutes with the oven door open.

NOTE: The secret here is to NOT beat the egg whites (which everyone seems to want to do) and to use sliced almonds, which look like flat slices. Slivered almonds are the ones that look like little sticks.
